- Intend to participate in commencement (June 7<sup>th</sup>)



# **Associate Degree Requirements**

- Major requirements (C or better)
- General Education Pattern
  - SCC Local GE (Plan A or Plan D)
  - CSU GE (Plan B)
  - IGETC (Plan C)
- Cumulative GPA 2.0 or higher
- 12 unit residency @ SCC (AA,AS 6 units in major)
- 60 unit requirement
  (AA/AS degree applicable, AA-T/AS-T CSU transferable)






LEFT SIDE - Certification Requirements / General Education
